### Alangudi (Guru - Jupiter)



This Navagraha temple is devoted to Lord Guru-planet Jupiter in the form of Lord Dakshinamurthy. This temple is also revered in the hymns of Thevaram and is considered as 'paadal Petra sthalam'. Devotees believe that worshipping Guru bhagavan brings solitude, joy and wisdom to their lives.

### Thirunallaru Saneeswaran Temple (Sani -Saturn)



This Navagraha temple honouring Lord Saneeshwarar (Sani) - Saturn is famous for its 'Emerald Lingam' (Idol of Lord Shiva). According to the mythology, the legendary King Nala is said to have been relieved of his afflictions, which were due to the malefic influence of Saturn, after worshiping in this temple. Devotees take a holy bath in a belief that it washes away misfortune and afflictions.

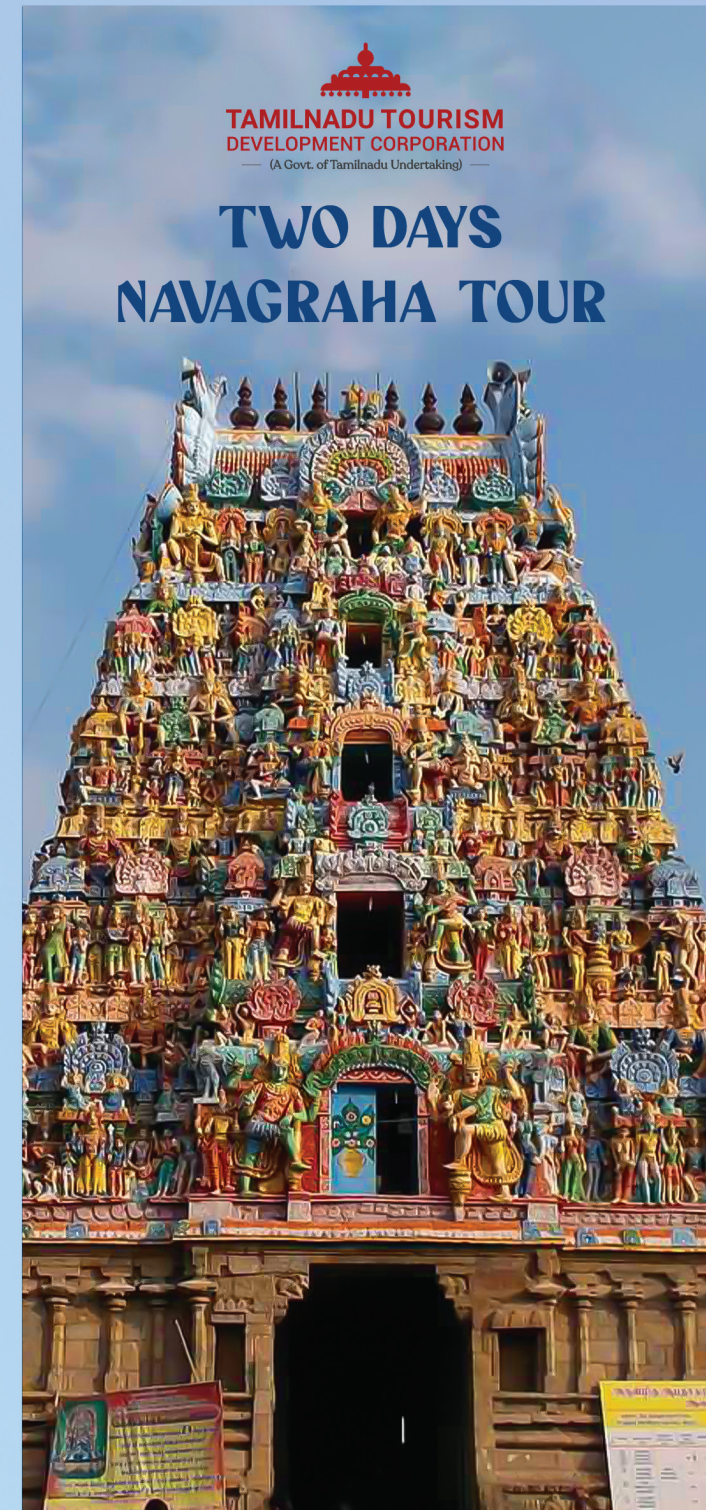

## Thingalur Kailasanathar Temple (Chandran - Moon)



This Navagraha temple honours Lord Chandra - Moon God. The temple is built in Dravidian style of Architecture with a 5- tiered Rajagopuram. Every year, thousands of devotees flock to the temple for offering prayers to seek the blessings of Moon God to nullify the harmful effects of the moon on their birth charts.

## Thirunageswaram Temple (Raghu)



This Navagraha temple honours the planet 'Raghu' - the northern lunar node. With his two consorts Nagavalli and Nagakanni, Lord Raghu bestows blessings upon his devotees. It is believed that worshipping Raghu will bring good health, courage and fortune.

## Suriyanar Kovil (Surya - Sun)



This Chola Dynasty-era Navagraha temple is devoted to the planet Suryan- 'Sun'. The Sun God is believed to provide happiness, success, and health.

## Kanchanur Temple (Sukran -I Venus)



This temple is built in Dravidian style of architecture and is dedicated to "Sukran" - Venus. The temple consists of 5-tier Rajagopuram and Lord Shiva, the presiding deity is worshipped as Agneeswaran. This planet in the navagraha is said to provide good health and wealth.

## Vaitheeswaran Kovil (Sevvai- Mars)



This temple honours the planet Sevvai- Mars among the Navagraha Temples. The presiding deity of the temple is Lord Shiva worshipped as Vaithyanathanthaswami. The temple is also famous for its palm leaf manuscripts - Naadi jothidam which aid in astrological predictions.

## Thiruvankadu (Budhan - Mercury)



This Navagraha temple is devoted to Lord Budhan - Mercury. The temple is built in Dravidian style of architecture and the presiding deity of the temple is Lord Shiva in the form of Suredharanyaswamy. Budan is the planetary ruler of studies, knowledge and art.

## Keezhaperumpallam (Ketu) Nagannathaswamy Temple

This temple is dedicated to Ketu, a shadow planet and is one of the nine Navagraha temples in Tamil Nadu. However, the main idol in the temple is that of "Naganatha Swamy" or Shiva. The temple has a
